## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Keep the tablet ( “Product” ) away from dust, water, damp areas, precipitation and humidity. Dust, water, liquids, precipitation and humidity may cause overheating, electrical leakage, and/or Product failure. The Product, battery, charger and AC adapter are not waterproof. Keep them away from liquid, fuels and chemicals. If the product gets wet do not dry via the use of an external heat source this could cause a fire or explosion.

Only use the battery and charger approved by the manufacturer. Using other brands may cause battery leakage, overheating, explosion or even fire. Do not use the Product where it might cause danger. Do NOT text and drive.

### **WARNING**

*Please note that any damages that occur due to such causes change the colour of the LDI (Liquid Damage Indicator). If the colour of LDI located inside the product changes, the product is to be considered ineligible for any free-of-charge repair services provided under the product's limited warranty.*

*Avoid exposing the product to environments with excessive dust or moisture.*

- *If your product becomes wet, wipe the microphone, speaker, and stereo jack with a dry cloth before use.*
- *Should your product or your hands become wet, dry them before handling the product.*
- *Do not use the product in places where it may be sprayed with high-pressure water (e.g. near a faucet or shower head) or submerge it in water for extended periods, as the product is not designed to withstand high water pressure.*
- *This product is not resistant to shock. Do not drop the product or subject it to shock. Doing so might damage or deform the main unit, causing water leakage.*
- *The touch screen and other features may not work correctly if the device is used while wet.*
- *Do not open or close the SIM/Memory card tray while the product is wet or immersed in water. Exposing the open tray to water or moisture may damage the product.*
- *Failure to follow these instructions may invalidate your device's limited warranty.*
- *If the device is wet, the LDI located inside the device changes in colour.*

*In this case, the device is ineligible for free-of-charge repair services provided under the device's limited warranty.*

## BATTERY USE

Handle and store batteries properly to avoid injury or damage. Most battery issues arise from improper handling, particularly the continued use of damaged batteries.

- Do not disassemble, open, crush, bend, deform, puncture, or shred.
- Do not modify or remanufacture, attempt to insert foreign objects into the battery, immerse or expose them to water or other liquids, expose to fire, explosion or other hazards.
- Only use the battery for the system for which it is specified.
- Only use the battery with a charging system that has been qualified with the system per CE(EU)/ RCM(AUS)/PSE(JPN) Certification Requirements for Battery System as applicable in your region.
- Use only the DOOGEE approved battery and or charger with your device. Using an unapproved battery or charger may present a fire, explosion, leakage or other risk hazard.
- Do not short-circuit a battery or allow metallic conductive objects to contact battery terminals.

- Only authorised service providers shall replace battery (If the battery is non-user replaceable).
- Promptly dispose of used batteries in accordance with local regulations.
- Battery usage by children should be supervised.
- Avoid dropping the tablet or battery. If the tablet or battery is dropped, especially on a hard surface, and the user suspects damage, take it to a service center for inspection.
- Improper battery use may result in a fire, explosion or other hazards. The recommended charging and discharging temperature range can be found in the products user manual

**Note:** The battery shall only be serviced by the manufacturer.

**CAUTION:** Risk of explosion if battery is replaced by an incorrect type. Dispose of used batteries per local regulations.

### **Cleaning and Maintenance**

The Product, the battery and the charger are not waterproof. Do not use them in places with high humidity, like a bathroom, and avoid spilling any liquids on the Product, battery or charger. Use a

soft cloth to clean the Product, the battery and the charger. Do not use alcohol, diluted liquid or benzene to clean the Product.

### **Disposal of Product and Batteries**

Follow local regulations regarding the disposal of mobile devices and batteries. In some areas, the disposal of these items in households or business trash may be prohibited.

Please follow your local regulations and recycle Product if required. Batteries must be recycled or disposed of properly.

### **Certification Information (RoHS)**

We at DOOGEE take our social responsibility seriously and are committed to serving our environment. We proudly state that DOOGEE tablets are RoHS compliant in keeping with these commitments.

### **Specific Absorption Rate (SAR) Safety**

This device has been designed to comply with applicable safety requirements for exposure to radio waves. These requirements are designed for the safety of all persons and follow scientific guidelines, which include safety margins.

- The radio wave exposure guidelines employ a unit of measurement known as the Specific Absorption Rate or SAR.

Tests for SAR are conducted using standardised methods, with the device transmitting at its highest certified power level in all used frequency bands.

- This device is designed and manufactured not to exceed the emission limits for radio frequency (RF) energy exposure.
- This device is in compliance with the Specific Absorption Rate (SAR) for general population or uncontrolled exposure limits (2.0W/kg) specified in Council Recommendation 1999/519 EC and had been tested in accordance with the measurement methods and procedures specified in AS/NZS 2772.2-2016.
- The highest SAR value can be found in the user manual for your product
- This device meets RF exposure guidelines when used in the normal position at least 5 mm away from the body.

When a carry case, belt clip or holder is used for body-worn operation, it should not contain metal and should position the product at least 5 mm away from your body. Ensure the above separation distance instructions are followed.

**NOTE:** Doogee or the manufacturer is not

responsible for any radio or TV interference caused by unauthorised modifications to the Product. Such modifications could void the user's authority to operate the equipment.

Data transmission is always initiated by software, which is passed down through the MAC, digital and analog baseband, and RF chip. The MAC initiates several special packets. These are the only ways the digital baseband portion will turn on the RF transmitter, which then turns off at the end of the packet. Therefore, the transmitter will be on only while one of the aforementioned packets is transmitted. In other words, this device automatically discontinues transmission in case of either absence of information to transmit or operational failure.



## **DOOGEE LIMITED WARRANTY**

### **WHO THIS WARRANTY COVERS**

This 24-month limited warranty extends only to the original purchaser of this product within the country of sale. This warranty is not transferable. This warranty is conditioned upon the proper use of the Product.

### **WHAT THIS WARRANTY COVERS**

DOOGEE offers you a limited warranty extending for the first twenty-four (24) month period to the original purchaser from the original purchase date with proof of purchase.

Should the Product, inbox accessories or any part during normal consumer usage and conditions be proven defective in material or workmanship that results in Product failure, such defect(s) will be repaired or replaced (with new or rebuilt parts) at DOOGEE' s discretion, without charge for parts or labour directly related to the defect.

### **WHAT THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER**

1. Warranty claims outside of the Product warranty period.
2. Damage or defects caused by using the

Product other than in the normal course.

3. Defects or damages resulting from accidental, misuse, abnormal use, abnormal conditions, improper storage, unauthorised modifications, unauthorised repair, improper installation, or other acts that are not the fault of DOOGEE.
4. Defects or damage resulting from excessive force or use of a metallic object when pressing the touch screen.
5. Product with altered, defaced or removed serial number.
6. Damage resulting from the use of accessories not approved by DOOGEE.
7. Damage from exposure to moisture, humidity, excessive temperature or extreme environment.
8. Liquid damage due to not properly sealed/locked accessories, ports and or battery latches of water resistance devices.
9. All surfaces and externally exposed parts are scratched or damaged due to normal customer use.
10. All software, including operating system software, third-party software, applications, and all other software.

11. Damage caused by ordinary wear and tear of the Product.
12. Customer abuse or other physical abuse or mistreatment of Product as evidenced by:
  - Missing required faceplate;
  - Damaged LCD or Lens (e.g., the product is either broken, cracked, smashed, bleeding, etc.);
